Student reports a positive COVID-19 test or diagnosis to the Dean of Students Office using the form at <a href="https://www.edu/covid19selfreport">www.edu/covid19selfreport</a>. The Dean of Students Office contacts the student to provide information about isolation, resources and an eventual return to campus. Students who can't isolate off campus are moved to on-campus isolation housing.

Student contacts instructors to get academic flexibility.
The Dean of Students Office assists with this as needed.

Dean of Students Office contacts close contacts identified by the student with information and resources.

## **DEFINITIONS:**

Close contact within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before illness onset until the time the patient is isolated.

**Isolate:** Stay home in a separate room from other household members and use a separate bathroom, if possible. Do not share personal household items, like cups, towels and utensils and avoid contact with other members of the household and pets. Learn more at **cdc.gov/coronavirus**.

Ouarantine: Stay home for 14 days from the last contact, watch for COVID-19 symptoms and follow CDC guidance.
