

TRANSFER & ADULT STUDENT Checklist

Must be completed prior to your arrival this semester.

- Register for classes with the help of your **Academic Advisor**. Your Advisor's contact information is on the right-hand side of your PAWS home page (uwm.edu/paws), and you can use these steps in choosing your courses: uwm.edu/onestop/enrolling/before-you-enroll
- Review the materials from your Orientation** including the QR code (cling) we provided to review important information on the student handbook website.
- Set up your Multi-Factor Authentication login using these directions: kb.uwm.edu/54768
- Mark **Fall or Winter Welcome** on your calendars, first week of the semester! Find more info at uwm.edu/welcome.
- Be on the lookout for communications about **Transfer & Adult Student Welcome Day** and review uwm.edu/TAWD to see how you'll participate in this tradition!
- Submit your final high school transcripts to the **Office of Undergraduate Admissions**:

- Submit your **FAFSA**: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.gov).
- Use your PAWS (uwm.edu/paws) account to accept your financial aid and pay your tuition.
- Tuition can also be paid directly to the Cashier's Office located in **Mitchell Hall, room 285**. Installment payment plan information is available at uwm.edu/onestop/finances/billing-and-payment or 414-229-4915.
- Check your UWM email account for emails from **Financial Aid, Housing, instructors**, and your **Student Success Center Peer Mentor**.
- Log in to "**Presence**" using your ePantherID and password to create a profile and check out the student organizations that UWM has to offer.
- Check out UWM's Virtual Bookstore (uwm.ecampus.com) to purchase your course textbooks.
- Check out the **PantherShop** for great UWM merchandise and supplies.
- Get your **Milwaukee County Transit System U-Pass** as early as a week before the beginning of the semester at Transportation Services (Union G25), just bring your Panther Card.
- Submit your AP, IB scores and/or other college credits**. Contact the appropriate testing agency to get your scores sent to UWM.
- If you feel comfortable, allow your parent/guardian to view your financial information in PAWS by granting them third party access. Log into PAWS; select "Campus Personal Information"; select "Grant Access to Others" and follow the directions.
